SUD Program offers accessible treatment options by accepting Medicaid and providing services on a sliding scale fee based on income. For individuals who are uninsured and meet eligibility criteria, the program is supported by HHSC funding through TRA, TRY, & TRF grants. Services are delivered in alignment with federal & state priority population guidelines, ensuring that those with the greatest need receive timely appropriate care.
